Clogged gutters cause problems:

Typical Gutter Guard Problems:

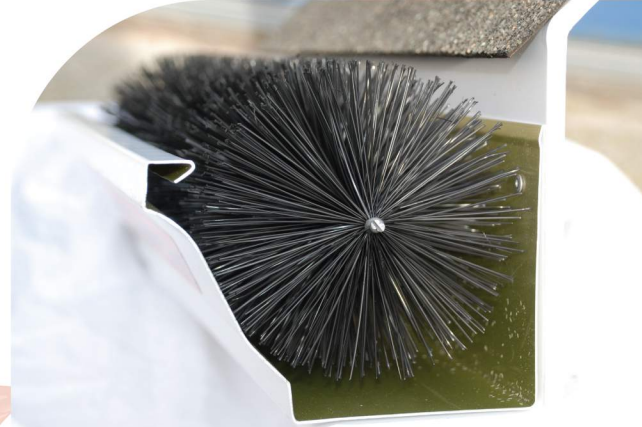


Screens & Covers

- Reduce gutter opening allowing water to overflow during heavy rain
- Interfere with roof / shingles which may cause roof warranty problems
- Makes access to gutters very difficult for cleaning or maintenance
- Collapse or blow out during severe weather
- Provides shelter for bees, birds and rodents to nest
- Dirt and rust can stain gutters and home
- Expensive! Professional installation can cost \$20 - \$30 / ft.

What Is GutterBrush?

GutterBrush is a simple “Twisted in Wire” brush similar to a large heavy duty bottle-brush. Constructed from a galvanized steel core and durable, UV protected polypropylene bristles.



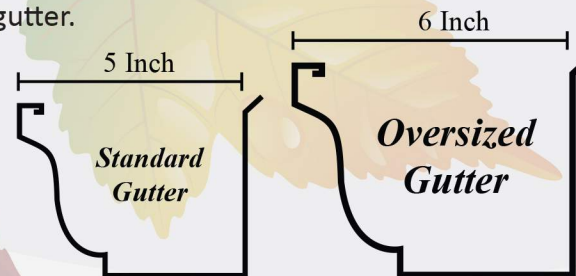
Available in diameters from 3.25 in up to 8 in.

How Does GutterBrush Work?

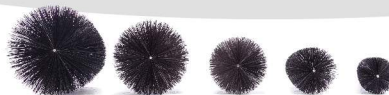
GutterBrush bristles fill your gutter blocking leaves and debris from entering while letting water flow through.

What Size Do I Need?

Measure the width across the top of your gutter from the back wall to the outer edge of your gutter.

Frequently Asked Questions

What about pine needles and small leaves or seeds?

Pine needles and small debris are among the most difficult to keep out of any gutter system. Some debris may get caught in the top of the brush but it is not usually enough to prevent water from flowing. During natural weather cycles most debris will dry out and blow away or break down into small particles that pass through the gutter.



Do I need to cut GutterBrush?

No. GutterBrush comes packed in 3 ft. lengths and we also include a couple of 18 in. sections to finish shorter spans that remain. GutterBrush can also be folded back into itself to create a custom length.



Will cleaning or maintenance be required?

All gutter guard systems will require maintenance at some point, so we do not make the false promise that you will “never touch your gutters again.”



One of the biggest advantages of GutterBrush is the simplicity of installation and removal. If cleaning or maintenance is required, simply remove sections of brush, and shake clear any debris. Access to your gutters remains simple.

What about snow and ice?

When black bristles are exposed to sunlight, they warm up. Many customers have reported that GutterBrush has reduced previous problems with ice dams and icicles. GutterBrush can also be used safely with heating cables.
